## Music Notes

Moon River, from Breakfast at Tiffany's, was only one of Henry Mancini's many musical compositions. Others include The Days of Wine and Roses, The Baby Elephant Walk, and the Pink Panther Theme.

Johnny Mercer was a prolific lyricist for over 40 years. While he wrote the lyrics for many songs, some of his best-known lyrics include Autumn Leaves, Come Rain or Come Shine, and Hooray for Hollywood.

Ray Henderson, sometimes along with B. G. (Buddy) De Sylva and Lew Brown, composed musical scores for many Broadway hits in the 1920's. Some of his best-known collaborations include It All Depends on You, You're the Cream in My Coffee, and Life is Just a Bowl of Cherries.

Moon Light in Vermont was first recorded in 1994 by the Billy Butterfield Orchestra with Margaret Whiting on vocals.
